The Northwest Oklahoma Osteopathic Foundation supported students in a variety of ways in 2023. Personalized scrubs were included in a box of treats sent to all first-year med students from NW Oklahoma.

The Foundation also provided 42 welcome boxes in 2023 to OSU medical students who completed rotations in Enid. The Foundation partnered with the Oklahoma Osteopathic Association and the OEFOM to provide stethoscopes to the first-year OSU-COM medical students at both the Tulsa and Tahlequah campuses. The NOOF helped two students from NW Oklahoma study for their MCAT in 2023 by reimbursing students for their MCAT prep materials.
